“Who controls and who should control the atmosphere in your school?” is the burning question we ask each student leader who attends THE WILDS Senior High Leadership Conferences. Clear biblical answers that lead senior high students to exert godly influence in Christian schools are needed and necessary. That is what this conference is all about. The Lord has used these conferences to challenge thousands of senior high students to stand up and be counted as servant-leaders for Christ in their Christian schools! This program is open to any high school desiring to expose students to the philosophy of servant-leadership for a concentrated period of time. THE WILDS Senior High Leadership Conference features experienced speakers Ken Collier, Matt Herbster, and Rand Hummel.

Participants are chosen by their schools using a variety of methods. Often the leaders are selected as an honor by faculty and administration. In some cases, the school provides scholarships or arranges outside sponsors. Juniors and Seniors are the prime candidates for the curriculum, though administrators can choose to send a limited number of up-and-coming leaders in ninth and tenth grades who are ready for the challenge. Schools can bring as many participants as they wish,

based on availability. It is imperative that an administrator accompany the delegation for the best results.

One administrator and one sponsor of the opposite gender attend free with five or more students. Additional sponsors are \$75 each.

General Information for Administrators and Faculty

Do not bring: Alcoholic beverages, drugs, tobacco, fireworks, ammunition, guns, weapons, scooters, skateboards, rollerblades, magazines, apparel with inappropriate graphics or lettering, or any type of electronic device, including, but not limited to cell phones, CD, DVD, MP3, or other music/media players, computers, PDAs, radios, TVs, and video games.

Conduct: As a Christian organization, we want the atmosphere at THE WILDS to be one of fun and adventure, while at the same time being one that is pleasing to God. For this reason we ask that no tobacco, drugs, or alcohol be brought onto the campsite. We will not permit their use at THE WILDS. In addition, we ask that every camper be in attendance at chapel and evening services.

Ladies/girls note: Please bring knee-length skirts or dresses for the evening services (skirts must not come above the knee). Any fashion worn must come at least to the top of the knee and cover the shoulders. Low necklines (front or back) are not acceptable camp attire. Loose-fitting pants, jeans, or knee-length fashions may be worn except when otherwise specified. Swimsuits should be one-piece and lined. Dark pants and shirts are required for rafting.

Men/boys note: Long pants and shirts with collars are required for evening services. Fashions to the knee may be worn at other times. Tank tops may not be worn except when designated by camp staff.

THE WILDS reserves the right to ask anyone to change his or her outfit if, in the estimation of the staff, it does not comply with these standards.

Camp Nurse: A registered nurse will be on duty at all times.

Meals: All meals are included; those on special diets should bring any needed supplements that can be prepared in a microwave.

Late Arrival: Should your arrival be delayed past the beginning of the first meal, please phone the camp office at (828) 884-7811 to give us an estimated arrival time.

Please remind parents: In the event of an emergency for which they need to reach their child, they may phone the camp office at (828) 884-7811.

Location: THE WILDS is located in North Carolina off US Highway 178. If coming north on I-85, take SC 11 (first exit after Georgia-South Carolina border) and turn left onto US 178. Four miles north of the North Carolina-South Carolina border, turn left onto Old Toxaway Road and follow the signs to the campsite. From North Carolina on I-26, take Exit 40. Follow NC 280 West to US 64. Continue on US 64 West through Brevard to Frozen Creek Road (1.5 miles beyond the Route 178 Rosman turnoff) and turn left. Follow the signs for 5.5 miles to the camp.
